## **Columbia Community Foundation Awards Two Lucille MacClellan Memorial Scholarships**

Two graduating Columbia High School seniors have been named the recipients of the 2012 Lucille MacClellan Memorial Scholarship presented by the Columbia Community Foundation at the Columbia High School Senior Awards ceremony on Tuesday May 15<sup>th</sup>.

Cheyanne Frosti will be attending Loyola University in Chicago where she plans to major in molecular biology.

Nicole Miller will be studying social work at Lorain County Community College.

Both of these students will be graduating from Columbia High School May 24th and each will receive \$1000 scholarships to help further their education.

Affectionately known as "Mrs. Mac", Lucille MacClellan contributed to Columbia Township as a school teacher, event organizer, and by providing financial assistance when she recognized a need. This scholarship's purpose is to acknowledge students who, like Lucille MacClellan, demonstrate a devotion to the community.

The Lucille MacClellan Memorial Scholarship is available to any resident of Columbia Township who is a current graduating senior in Columbia High School aspiring to attend a two-year or four-year college, trade school, technical institute, or other post-secondary education program. The application process for the 2013 Lucille MacClellan Memorial Scholarship will open in January.
